Rationale

The Angel Kindergarten Admission Policy exists to inform the community regarding the school's stance on admission. The policy makes clear the guidelines that are to be followed by both the school and the applicant before admission, during the admission process, and after the student has been admitted to the school.

Initial visit

First, we ask parents to come to the general information meeting held once a year regarding admission. After that, families who wish to apply will be asked to apply online first and book a time, then come and visit the school. During the visit, the principal, vice-principal, or one of the teachers will give prospective students and their families a guided tour of the premises. This will give them a general idea of what our school looks like, and what we do. Families will also be able to meet staff members to establish trust between both parties. During the initial visit, parents will be given pamphlets, and other documents related to the operation of the school. They will be asked to read through these documents, and once read through and understood, the parents will be able to apply for admission.

Interview

Inclusion is an important part of Angel-Kindergarten. We strive to provide reasonable accommodation for all children. After applying for admission, parents and their children will be asked to come in for an interview. The purpose of this interview is the following:

- To determine the child's development.
- To determine whether the child is able to manage group living.
- To determine whether Angel Kindergarten can offer adequate support for the child's needs (for example physical or behavioral conditions)

After the conclusion of the interview, the school will decide if the child is applicable for admission to the school.

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Student-centered learning

Angel Kindergarten is an International Baccalaureate World School. As an IB World School, we will learn together with the students as a community, where we see students having a central role, and that their interests, ideas, and opinions are integral to our learning community. We think that the learning process is more vital than an end product, and that student development comes from different kinds of experiences. Students are also allowed to express their understanding in a variety of ways.

When joining our community, it is important that everyone acknowledges this in order to promote an open and accepting learning environment.

Collaboration

Angel Kindergarten thinks that it's important that learning doesn't end in the classroom, but is extended and enhanced through different ways. This includes asking the learning community for its support in the learning process. This means that as a community, we take part in the students' learning activities, we support their learning through reflecting together with the students, and we participate in events and workshops arranged by the school.
